## VACCINATION PROGRAM

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Chickens can be vaccinated from 10 weeks of age onwards. To achieve a protection in layers and breeders of 52 weeks post vaccination, two vaccinations are required. The first dose has to be administered at the age of 10-12 weeks and the repeated dose a few weeks before the onset of egg production. The interval between two vaccinations has to be at least 4 weeks.

**DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION**Intramuscular injection of 0.25 ml of vaccine in chickens from 10 till 12 weeks old and a revaccination ultimately several weeks before lay. Interval between vaccinations at least 4 weeks.

### VACCINATION REACTION

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In healthy animals no abnormal clinical reactions are observed. Slight transient swelling at the site of injection for some weeks after vaccination is occasionally observed.
